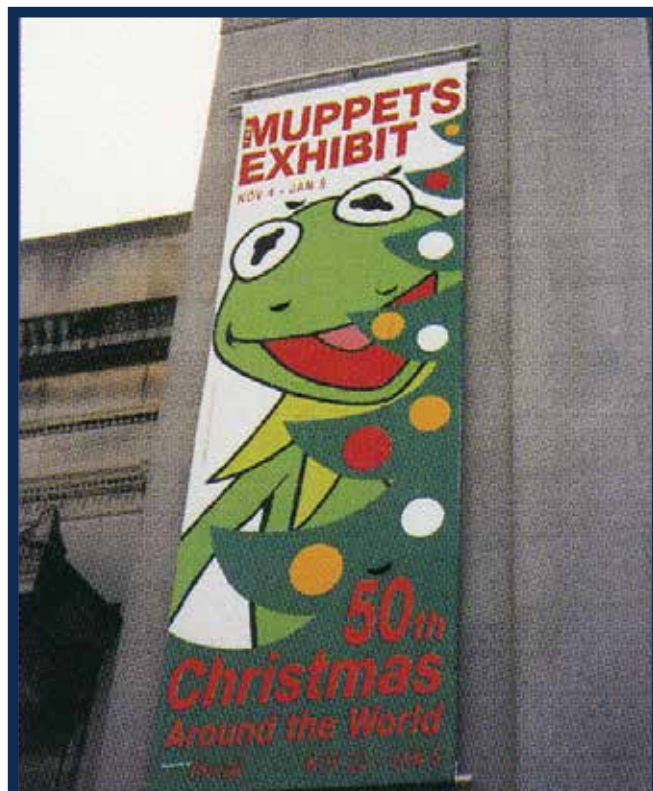

Remember that a positive school culture can result in better student attendance and achievement.

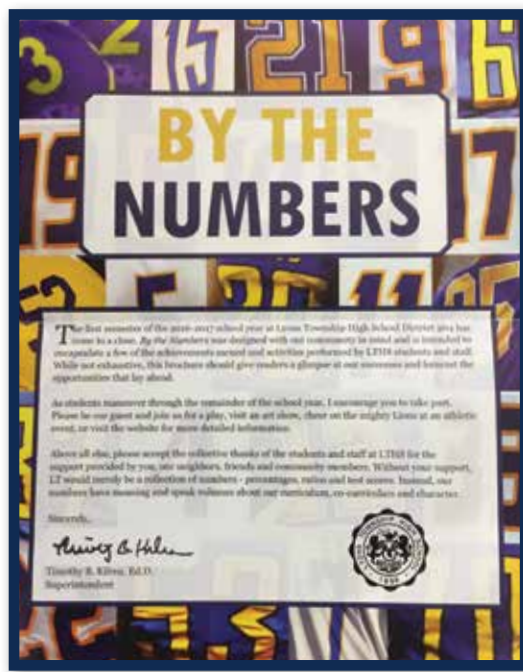

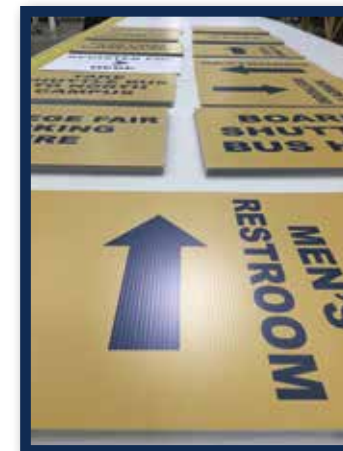
